Scholarship Criteria

Applicants must:

- Be a graduating senior attending a Burlington/Camden County High School.
- Have applied to an accredited four-year college or university and the student **MUST** be accepted as a full-time freshman for the fall term of 2023 or spring 2024 at an accredited college or university.
- Academic record must be at a minimum 2.7 GPA on a 4.0 scale or equivalent. Submission of an official school transcript will be required.
- Submit an official transcript indicating overall GPA and/or class rank. Transcripts must include all grades through the first semester of applicant's senior year.
- Submit two (2) original letters of recommendation. The first must be from an educator who can attest to the academic knowledge of you as a student. The second letter may be from an employer, community leader, minister, or someone other than a family member who can attest to your character and any other significant achievement
- Submit copies of all letters of acceptance from colleges and universities.
- The application and ALL required document will be emailed to info@kilgo6.com. Any missing documentation will disqualify applicants.
